HOUSING CENSUS 1-15 DECEMBER, 1980

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

The first ever comprehensive Housing Census was conducted from 1st to 15th December, 1980. The objective was to ascertain in detail the housing conditions in Pakistan so that appropriate policies can be framed to meet this basic human need.

2. The questions in Housing Census pertained to five broad characteristics— number of rooms in the housing unit, nature of tenure, period of construction, building material used for outer walls and roof and availability of facilities for drinking water, lighting and cooking. In urban areas it was also enquired whether the house has a kitchen, bath room and latrine. The form in which the questions were asked can be seen in the questionnaire which is at *Annexure -I*.

3. Housing characteristics vary considerably between urban and rural areas. Therefore, separate tables have been compiled for urban and rural areas at the national level as well as for all the four provinces and Islamabad. The tables of the NWFP exclude FATA whose information with respect to period of construction, construction material and availability of facilities of drinking water, lighting and cooking is indicated in a separate Table 7. Information on number of rooms and nature of tenure was not collected in FATA.

Number of rooms

4. The logical question for this enquiry should have been the number of square metres of covered space in the house as rooms can be big and small and 2 to 3 small rooms may have the same area as one big room. However, as the majority of the population is illiterate and not generally aware of the number of square metres or the square feet of covered/built up areas of their houses, it was considered advisable to ask the number of rooms in the house. The number of rooms did not include verandah, kitchen, store, bath room and latrine.

5. About half of the housing units in Pakistan have only a single room with six persons living in it. Thirty percent households have 2 rooms, and 11 percent have 3 rooms. Only 8 percent live in houses with 3 or more rooms.

Nature of tenure

6. In rural areas of Pakistan, 83 percent of the households own their dwelling units and only 2 percent are rented; fifteen percent of the people live in rent free accommodation which they do not own.

7. In the urban areas 68 percent of the households live in their own accommodation and 22 percent in rented accommodation, whereas 10 percent are living rent free.

Period of construction

8. There has been a sharp increase in construction of housing units during the last 10 years, as 44 percent of the houses have been constructed in this period as compared to 37 percent constructed between 1947 and 1970. Only 19 percent of the housing units were constructed before 1947.

Material used in outer walls and roofs

9. In this characteristics there is great disparity between urban and rural areas. In urban areas 43 percent of the households had walls of bricks/concrete/stone with cement finish whereas in rural areas this percentage is only 5. Similarly, 26 percent of the housing units in urban areas have R.C.C/R.B.C roofs whereas in rural areas this percentage is only 1. In rural areas 59 percent of the households were kutchamade of unbaked bricks with mud finish. The roofing may be better than the quality of the walls but a mud wall can hardly support a good quality roof.

Source of drinking water

10. Only 21 percent of the households have access to piped water. Of this 13 percent have the facility inside the house and 8 percent outside the house. Forty six percent of the population obtains drinking water from a handpump mostly inside the house. The remaining gets it from well, pond and stream.

Source of lighting

11. One third of Pakistan's households have electricity for lighting and two-third use kerosene oil.

Cooking fuel

12. Seventy percent of housing units use wood for cooking fuel, 17 percent use cow-dung, 6 percent use kerosene oil and only another 6 percent use gas for cooking fuel.

Availability of separate kitchen, bathroom and latrine facility (in urban areas only)

13. Forty four percent of the households in urban areas have a separate kitchen and 47 percent have a separate bathroom. A separate kitchen or bathroom was therefore, available to about half the urban population and the other half did not have it at all. The sharing was only 4 percent in case of kitchen and 6 percent in case of bathroom.

14. Similarly 63 percent households had separate latrine (22 percent with flush) and 27 percent households had no latrine facility, with the balance 10 percent sharing it.

15. The Housing Census, which also involved the difficult work of marking a census number on every house in Pakistan, was a gigantic operation of immense socioeconomic importance. The completion of this task was made possible by the untinted cooperation of Government Departments in the Central and Provincial Governments. The most arduous work was done by the enumerators with great dedication. We owe a deep debt of gratitude to all those who worked to make this pioneering exercise a great success and hope that the data will be useful in making better housing policies at all levels.
