PREFACE

The fourth decennial population census was conducted from 1st to 15th March, 1981. This preceded by the first ever fullfledged Housing Census from 1st to 15th December, 1980. In the Population Census, two questionnaires were used; a short one (Annexure-A) containing questions on names of household members, their relationship to head of household, sex, age, marital status, religion, literacy, ability to read the Holy Quran (for Muslims only), educational attainment and language spoken in the household and a long one (Annexure-B) which included all questions of the short questionnaire and some more, namely, field of education, district of previous residence, duration of residence at present district, activity, employment status, occupation, industry, disability, etc. The long questionnaire was used for households selected on probability basis. The sample covered 5 percent of households in rural areas.

This report comprises four parts. In Part-I, general description of the district and the main findings of the 1980 Housing Census and the 1981 Population Census have been highlighted. Part-II and Part-III consist of Statistical Tables of the Housing Census and the Population Census respectively. In Part-IV, various annexures mentioned in the text of this report have been given.

The tabulation of topics common in both the questionnaires pertains to complete enumeration, whereas tabulation of additional topics in the long questionnaire are the estimates based on the sample data.

The number and scope of statistical tables have been extended and cover data from the Housing Census (Annexure-D) also. Definitions and concepts of the topics in the questionnaires and tables are given at annexure-E. Map of Chitral district is at annexure-I.

Population Census, conducted once in a decade, is a gigantic operation of immense national importance. This report gives a demographic profile of the district. Thousands of field and office workers have contributed in producing this report. Our Organisation owes a deep debt of gratitude to all those who worked at different stages of census operations and made their inputs for this final output. We also hope that the data presented in this report will be used for planning the progress of the people of this place.

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Part—I

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE DISTRICT AND MAIN FINDINGS OF THE CENSUSES

SECTION 1—GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE DISTRICT

1.1 LOCATION

Chitral is the northern extreme district of Pakistan. It lies from 35°-15' to 36°-55' north latitudes and 71°12' to 73°-55' east longitudes. The district is bounded by Afghanistan on the north and west, Gilgit and Swat districts on the east and Dir district on the south.

The total area of the district is 14,850 sq. km.

1.2 TOPOGRAPHY

Chitral is a land of high mountain ranges and deep valleys. It is surrounded by the Hindukush range in the north and west, the Mushamber range in the east and the Hindu Raj range in the south. There are about 100 mountain peaks above 6,000 metres. The highest mountain peak is Trichmir which is 7,778 metres. In between the mountain ranges there are passes which link Chitral district with the neighbouring areas. Some of the well known passess are the Kotal Drosh the Shandur, the Borughul and the Lowari. The largest valley of the distict is the Chitral-Mastuj valley which is about 300 kilometres long from Borughul range to Arandu in the south. The width of the valley varies from 2 to 15 kilometres.

1.3 CLIMATE

The climate of the district is nearly dry. The summer season is cool while the winter is chilly. Wide spread snow fall occurs in winter. During winter the northernly winds blow constantly bringing the temperature down considerably. The monthly mean maximum and minimum temperature and precipitation, recorded at Drosh, is given below :

1.4 AGRICULTURE

Chitral being a hilly area is not very rich in agriculture. The main crops during *Rabbi* are barley and wheat and in *Kharif* maize and rice. The main source of irrigation are channels of various sizes and capacity.

In 1980-81, the total farm area was 98,671 hectares. The total cultivated area was 18,132 hectares out of which 17,037 hectares were net-sown. However, the cropped area was 26,021 hectares. The area under forest was 40,954 hectares.

The acreage and production figures of major crops, grown in 1980-81, are given in the following table :

1.5 INDUSTRY

There is no large scale industry of any importance. The main cottage industry is the Woolen Pattee. Quality woolen cloth is manufactured from the local woolen old type *Khadis*, *Chughas* are also prepared. Besides, *Namdās* are made and supplied to other parts of the country. The other cottage industries are silk embroidered caps, table cloth, baskets and handbags which are popular among tourists.

A Woolen Centre, a Pattee centre and Sericulture Centre are working at Chitral to impart training to the local people in these trades.

1.6 COMMUNICATION

Chitral is blocked by high mountains on all sides. Lowari tunnel which is near completion connects it with other parts of the country. It will remain open throughout the year. The length of metalled roads was very small as compared to unmetalled roads. The total length of unmetalled roads was 1,251 kilometres.

The area being hilly, there is no railway service in this district. However Chitral is connected by regular air service with Peshawar.

1.7 EDUCATION

The following table gives the educational facilities available, in 1981, in the district.

1.8 HEALTH

There were 3 hospitals having 56 beds and 35 dispensaries in the district.

SECTION 2—MAIN FINDINGS OF 1980 HOUSING CENSUS

2.1 HOUSING UNITS, HOUSEHOLD SIZE AND ROOMS

The total number of housing units in Chitral were 29,411. Eighty per cent housing units had either one or two rooms. The degree of crowding was seven persons per housing unit and three persons per room.

2.2 TENURE

Ninety-two per cent of the housing units were owner occupied, 5 per cent rent-free and the remaining 3 per cent rented.

2.3 PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION

Forty-four per cent of the housing units were constructed before the creation of Pakistan in 1947. Thirty per cent were built during 1947-70, 14 per cent during 1971-75 and 12 per cent during 1976-80.

2.4 CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL OF OUTER WALLS AND ROOFS

The main construction material of the outer walls was unbaked bricks and mud used by 62 per cent of the housing units. Thirty-four per cent had used baked bricks and stones. Roofs of ninety nine per cent housing units were built of girder/beam and baked bricks etc.

2.5 SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER

Ninety seven per cent household used spring/river/stream water. Piped water was used by only 2 per cent households.

2.6 SOURCE OF LIGHT

Kerosene was used for light by 93 per cent of the housing units. Electricity was used by only 4 per cent of the housing units.

2.7 COOKING FUEL USED.

Ninety-nine per cent of the housing units used wood/brush-wood for this purpose.

SECTION 3—MAIN FINDINGS OF 1981 POPULATION CENSUS

3.1 POPULATION SIZE, GROWTH AND DISTRIBUTION

The total population of Chitral district was 208,560 according to the 1981 Population Census. It increased by 31.2 per cent during the 1972-81 inter-censal period (8 years and 5½ months) at an average annual growth rate of 3.3 per cent.

The total area of the district is 14,850 sq. k.m. which gives a population density of 14 persons per sq. km.

The following table gives intercensal increase in population size since the 1951 Population Census:—

There is no urban locality in this district. There are 501 (excluding 2 un-inhabited) Mauzas/villages. Four Mauzas had individual population of two to five thousands, 142 Mauzas between five and two hundreds and 355 Mauzas had less than five hundreds.

3.2 SEX, AGE AND MARITAL STATUS COMPOSITION

The sex ratio (males per 100 females) was 107. The population of infants (below 1 year) was 3.4 percent. The children below 5 and 15 years were 15.1 and 42.1 percent respectively. The adult population (i.e. 18 years and above) was 46.0 percent. The women of child-bearing age (i.e. 15-49 years) were 45,405 (i.e. 45.1 percent of female population). The age-dependency ratio (i.e. the percentage ratio of population below 15 and above 65 years to population of 15-64 years) was 83 percent.

The population of 15 years and above was 120,740, out of which 19.8 percent were never married. The currently married were 73.4 percent. The divorcees and widowers were 0.4 and 6.3 percent respectively.

3.3 LITERACY AND EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

The literacy ratio was 12.7 percent. The male literacy ratio was 21.9 percent as compared to 2.3 percent of females.

The Muslim Population of 10 years and above was 142,869, out of which 29.7 per cent could read the Holy Quran. The percentages of males and females who could read the Holy Quran were 60.6 and 39.4 respectively.

The population of 5 years and above was 176,976, out of which 6.8 percent were attending educational institutions. The enrolment ratio for age group 5-19 years was 14.9 percent—25.1 percent for males and 4.2 percent for females. The ratios for age groups 5-9, 10-14, 15-19 and 20-24 years were 9.8, 22.1, 14.4 and 5.3 percent respectively.

There were 18,482 persons who had passed primary and above levels of education, out of which 47.1, 27.8, 17.0, 3.4, 1.6 and 0.7 percent had completed primary, middle, matriculation, intermediate, graduation (General education) and post-graduation respectively.

3.4 CIVILIAN LABOUR FORCE

The labour force (i.e. those working and looking for work) constituted 30.2 percent of the total population. The male and female labour force participation rates were 54.9 and 3.6 percent respectively.

The un-employment rate was 0.7 percent. The male and female un-employment rates were 0.4 and 4.7 percent respectively.

The major occupation group was "Agricultural, animal husbandry and forestry workers, fishermen and hunters", which constituted 78.4 percent of the total labour force. The other important occupation groups were "Service workers" and Production and related workers, transport equipment operators and labourers", which were 6.8 and 6.5 percent respectively of the total labour force.

The major economic activity in the district was "Agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing", which absorbed 79.7 percent of the total working population. The other important economic activities were "Community, social and personal services" and "Wholesale and retail trade and restaurants and hotels", which employed 7.9 and 6.5 percent respectively of the total working population.

3.5 MIGRATION

The total immigrants were 1,478 (i.e. 0.7 of the total population). The male and female immigrants were fifty percent each. The persons who had migrated into the district during the last 5 years i.e. after March, 1976 were 82.3 percent while 8.3 percent had migrated before 5 years but after March, 1971. The remaining 9.4 percent had migrated 10 years earlier. During the last ten years 1,757 persons had gone abroad and were still residing there at the time of Census enumeration.

DEFINITIONS AND CONCEPTS

Urban Areas

All localities which were either metropolitan corporation, municipal corporation, municipal committee, town committee or cantonment at the time of the census, were treated as urban.

Household

A household means a group of persons living together who have collective arrangement for eating. A person living alone was also considered to constitute a household. The distinguishing characteristic of a household is its common cooking arrangement.

Housing Unit

A housing unit means a separate and independent place of abode, inhabited by one household and, if vacant, meant for habitation by one household. It does not necessarily mean a separate building. A building may have one or more housing units. Furthermore, any place not intended for habitation but occupied by a household at the time of census was also treated as a housing unit.

Room

A room is defined as a space in a housing unit having a roof and walls from roof to floor. This includes sleeping, dining, drawing, study, children's and servant's rooms but excludes kitchen, bathroom, latrine, store, balcony, porch and motor garage.

Age

Age is recorded as of the last birthday.

Marital Status

Marital status has been classified into never-married, married, widowed and divorced. Never-married applies to persons who have never been married. Married includes all persons who are at present married and living as husband and wife as well as those married persons living apart but having a living wife/husband. Those couples, whose marriage (Nikah) had been solemnized but giving away ceremony had not taken place, were also treated as married. Widowed applies to a person whose husband or wife was dead but who had not married again. Divorced applies to both divorcer and divorcee, if not remarried.

Religion

Religion is recorded and tabulated as informed by the respondents.

Literate

A person who can read a newspaper and write a simple letter, in any language, is treated as literate.

Field of Education

(a) *General Education*

It includes educational programmes of primary, middle, matriculation, intermediate and bachelor's degree in arts or science.

(b) *Technical/Engineering*

It includes engineering educational programmes in the fields of electrical, electronic, industrial, metallurgical, mining, mechanical, agricultural, forestry, chemical, petro-chemical, aviation, nautical, etc. It also includes programmes in survey, drafting and designing, all types of engineering technician programmes, all types of trade, craft and industrial programmes. Architectural and town planning programmes are also included.

(c) *Medicine/Tib*

It includes educational programmes of medical diagnostic and treatment techniques, medicine and surgery, medical X-ray techniques, dentistry, pharmacy, etc.

(d) *Health*

It includes educational programmes of public health, nursing, mid-wifery and other health related auxiliary programmes.

(e) *Commerce/Business Administration*

It includes educational programmes of typing, shorthand, clerical, secretarial, operation of office machines, book keeping, accountancy, electric data processing, business administration, marketing and sales, financial management and investment analysis, public administration, institutional administration, personal administration and other commercial, business and public administration programmes.

(f) *Teaching*

It includes all educational programmes which enable the teachers to teach all types of subjects to all categories of students. It includes education science programmes.

(g) *Agriculture/Forestry/Animal Husbandry*

It includes educational programmes of agriculture, forestry and fishing including general agriculture, animal husbandry, horticulture and gardening, crop husbandry, agricultural technology, food sciences and technology, veterinary, medicine, fishery science and technology, etc.

(h) *Law*

It includes educational programmes in jurisprudence, history of law, international law, labour law and maritime law, and other laws.

Civilian Labour Force

The civilian labour force means persons of 10 years and above age, of either sex, who are working for pay or profit and those not working but looking for work.

The labour force participation rate means the percentage persons in labour force to total population.

In collection of the labour force data "usual status" approach has been adopted as against the approach of labour force surveys, where data is usually collected on "current status" basis.

Occupation

Occupation means the main job, profession, trade or kind/type of work usually performed by a person. In case of more than one occupation, the principal occupation is recorded. The principal occupation is that in which the person works most of the time.

Economic Activity (Industry)

Economic activity/industry means the activity of the organisation, or business in which a person usually works.

Employment Status

(a) *Self-employed*

Self-employed is a person who operates his own farm, business, or industry or practices a profession but does not employ any hired help, paid either in cash or kind.

(b) *Government employee*

A Government employee is a person who works in any government/semi-government organisation for pay.

(c) *Private employee*

A Private employee is a person who works, for pay, for person/farm/shop/firm/organisation/office which is not run or managed by the federal/provincial/local government/autonomous body.

(d) *Employer*

Employer means a person who operates his own farm, business or industry or practices a profession and who employs one or more persons for the purpose.

(e) *Un-paid family helper*

Un-paid family helper means a person who works, without pay or profit, on family farm, business or industry.

Migrant Population

The migrant population means those who have moved from one administrative district to another administrative district. It excludes population who have moved within a district.

Disability

Disability refers to the physical and organic handicap of a person due to natural deformity or deficient functioning of any limb resulting from accident, disease, etc. It includes blind, deaf & dumb, crippled, mentally retarded and insane.
