Two teams from Lahore School of Economics, represented by Haris Salman & Nihaa Sajid, and Daniyal Nasir & Nimra Afzal, reached the semi-finals and final of 15th Annual GIKI Debates which were held from 11th – 13th November 2016, after a consistent performance in the 5 preliminary rounds against the top-tier teams from across Pakistan. This was the first time in the history of LSEAD that two teams reached the semi-finals at one of the most competitive tournaments of the circuit. Daniyal Nasir also bagged the best English speaker of the tournament.

UET MODEL UNITED NATIONS 2016

Lahore School of Economics won the best delegation with every individual performing remarkably in their tremendously competitive committees while representing the institute at UETMUN. This tournament was held from 25th – 27th November 2016. The delegation consisted of first-time MUN speakers with no prior experience. The following were the winners; Nasar Bilal (Best Delegate), Moaiyad Khan and Maham Fakhar (Outstanding Delegate), Shehryar Ahmed and Salman Masood (Honorable Mention).

LAHORE SCHOOL DEBATE '17

The ninth edition of Lahore's biggest Asian parliamentary debate competition, Lahore School Debate, was held from 22nd – 24th January at Lahore School of Economics. Hosting 110 teams from all across Pakistan, in both English and Urdu debates, all previous statistical records were broken due to the immense efforts put in by the host team. Overwhelming response was shown by the finest debaters in the circuit with both schools and universities sending their best teams to fight for the prestigious trophy. An unprecedented response could be seen from the Debating Society of Pakistan when the freshly selected Pakistan Debate Team, which has the honor to represent Pakistan at international debating competitions including World School Debating Championship, was also registered and participated in the event. After three intense preliminary rounds on the first day, the event moved forward with the quarter-final and the semi-final for both English and Urdu. The final match was held on 24th January with the Urdu final being between University College Lahore (UCL) and Punjab University (PU), judged by renowned speakers of the circuit including Mr. Roohullah Gulzari, Mr. Umair Ghumman, Mr. Haris Salman, Ms. Nimra Afzal and Mr. Afzan Munir. After an intense debate, University College Lahore was unanimously declared the winner. This was followed by the English Final between Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS) and

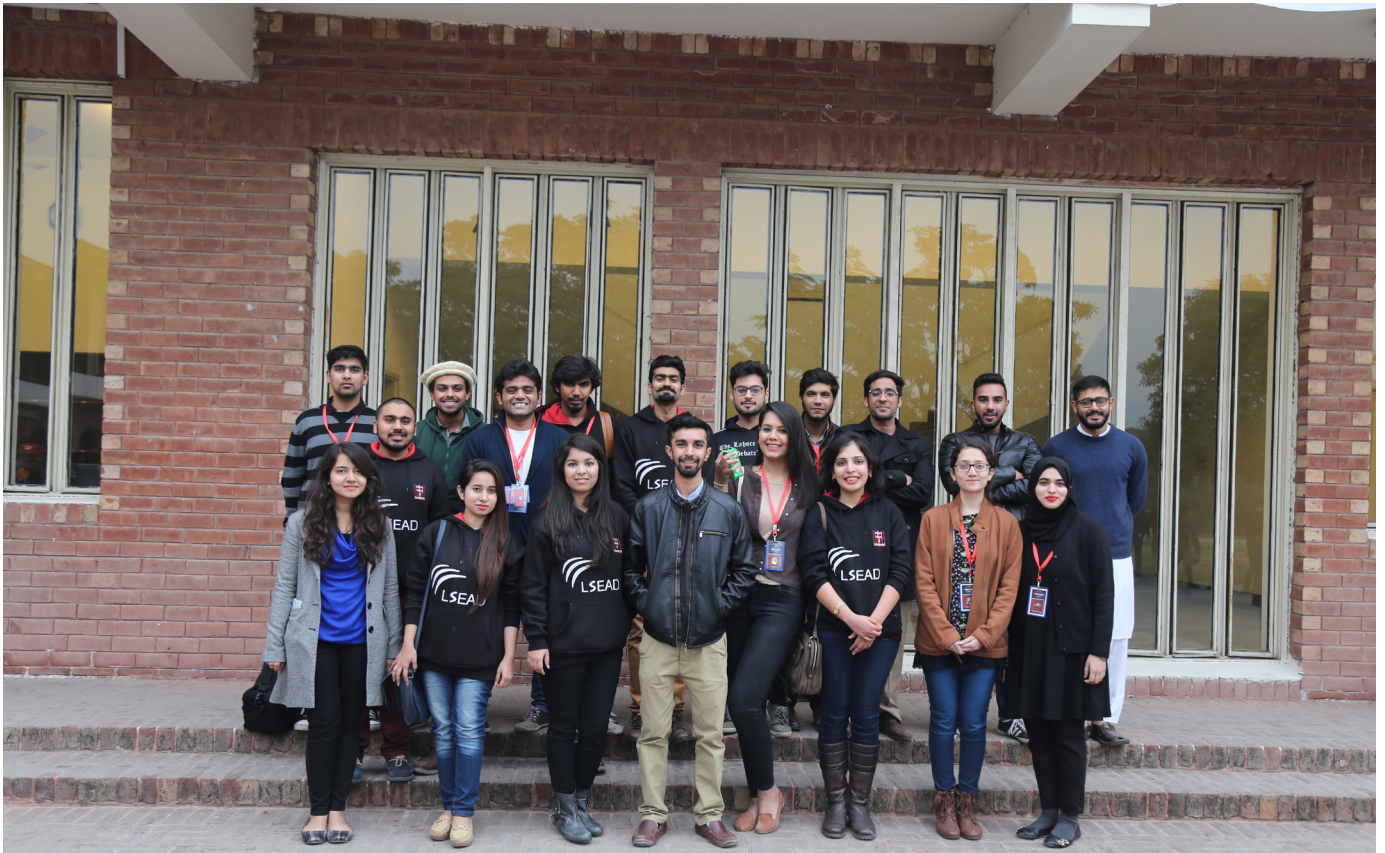

A 7-2 split decision was given in favor of LUMS. Hafiz Usman (LUMS) won the best speaker award for English while Naima Arshad (PU) won the best speaker for Urdu in the university category while Sarem Leghari (BDC) and Hamza Ali (LGS JT) won best-speaker awards in English and Urdu U-19 category.

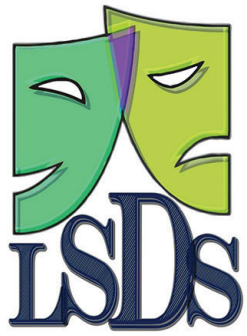

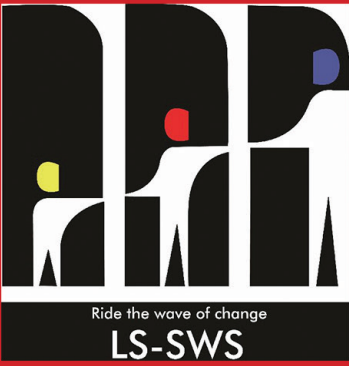
