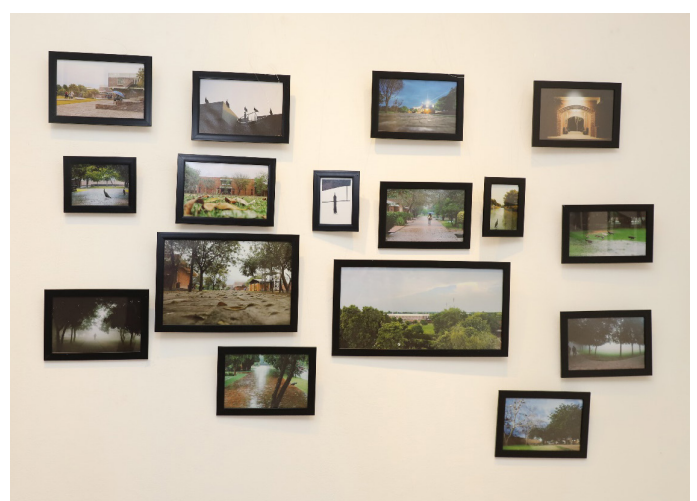
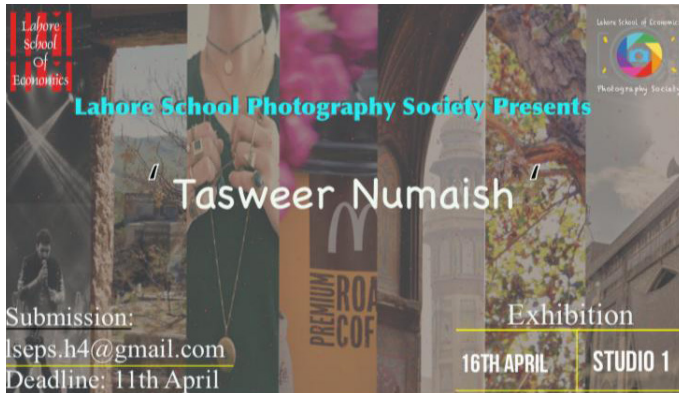
WORKSHOP ON ROLE OF PHOTOGRAPHY IN ADVERTISING IN COLLABORATION WITH NIKON

TALK BY DR. MATHEW MCCARTNEY

The Lahore School's Economics Society organized a session with Dr. Matthew McCartney who has been conducting his research on the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). During this seminar he talked about his main preliminary findings. The first one was whether Pakistan would experience gains or losses from the CPEC. He concluded that Pakistan's economy was independent enough to grow on its own and without the help of CPEC, as even though CPEC would have certain benefits, its resulting losses such as the growing Trade Deficit with China could not be ignored. He further presented some historical evidence of how infrastructural development proved to be beneficial for some countries whereas resulted in losses for others. Secondly, he also believes there will be very few transformative benefits and little complementarity effects to Pakistan regarding CPEC. In the last quarter of Dr. Matthew's seminar, he discussed the requirements for applying to Oxford University for MBA, MPhil, and Phd. Also mentioned certain scholarships for Pakistani students and greatly emphasized on the fact that students from LSE should definitely apply to Oxford University



ECONOTHON

Econothon 2019 was hosted by the Economics Society at the Lahore School of economics on the 4th April 2019. This one-day event was begun in the morning and ended with a social event, Qawali night followed by a formal dinner which was held at Peeru's café and attended by all the participants. 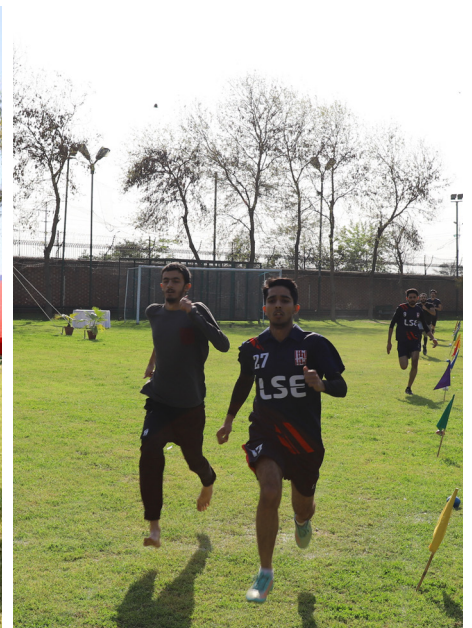


INTRA ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIP'19
